Section C: Subject Selection

Language Selection Grade 4:

The school offers three official languages: English, Afrikaans and isiZulu. English is taught at Home Language level and is also the medium of instruction. The additional languages are given equal status from Grade 1- 3, whereafter boys elect to take either Afrikaans or isiZulu at First Additional Language level. Select your language of choice: Afrikaans isiZulu

Grade 8 and 9 boys follow a general course with the following subjects:

English Home Language, Afrikaans First Additional Language OR isiZulu First Additional Language, Mathematics, Physical Sciences and Life Sciences (Natural Sciences), Geography and History (Social Sciences), Visual Arts, Drama, Music (Creative Arts), Economic Management Sciences (including Accounting), Computers and Life Orientation.

*If you are seeking admission into Grades 8 or 9, select the language of choice:

Afrikaans isiZulu

Grade 10, 11 and 12 boys follow the FET learning programme. A pupil's academic programme consists of seven subjects:

Compulsory

English, Afrikaans OR isiZulu, Mathematics OR Mathematical Literacy, Life Orientation

THREE optional subjects

Accounting*, Business Studies, Dramatic Art, Geography, History, Information Technology *, Life Sciences, Music, Physical Science*, Visual Art

- * The following subject entrance requirements apply:
- Boys who choose Maths Literacy as a subject may not choose Physical Science as an elective.
- Boys who wish to continue with Mathematics must attain a mark of 40% for Grade 9 Maths. If their marks are between 40% and 50%, it will be compulsory for them to attend extra lessons.
- Boys who wish to take Information Technology must attain a pass mark of 60% for Grade 9 Maths and write the IT Entrance Examination to determine suitability prior to acceptance.
- Boys who wish to take Physical Science must have qualified for Mathematics and must attain a mark of 55% for Science.
- Boys who wish to take Accounting must attain a pass mark of 50% for Maths.

Boys granted official immigrant status are exempt from the First Additional Language and take FOUR core subjects.
