



Let's make Term 2 one to remember. Believe in yourself, aim high, and don't forget to enjoy the journey.



THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS



The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a profound and enduring symbol within the Catholic Faith, representing the immense love and mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is a special form of devotion to Jesus—the focus being his Heart, which exemplifies our Lord's redemptive suffering for the whole world.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus began in the eleventh and twelfth centuries, but became more prominent through our Lord's private revelations to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the seventeenth century. Between 1673 and 1675, St. Margaret Mary, a nun in the Visitation Convent at Paray-le-Monial, France, received several visions of Jesus. In these visions, Christ revealed his Heart as a symbol of his boundless love for humanity and emphasized the need for people to return his love through devotion and prayer.


One popular devotion is the First Friday Devotion, where Catholics receive Holy Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months, as Jesus requested to St. Margaret Mary. This practice makes reparations for the sins committed against the Heart of Christ and enables us to grow closer to him. Jesus promised St. Margaret Mary that he will grant twelve special and powerful graces to the devout soul who completes the nine first Fridays.


The Monthly Beatitude

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God" is the sixth beatitude which Jesus shared in the Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew (Matthew 5:8). This beatitude highlights the importance of having a sincere, truthful, and undivided heart focused on God.


I'm a student right now, the thing about students always being broke is the truth.

DEVOTION

Faith is more than belief; it's a posture of the heart. Hebrews 11:6 tells us plainly that without faith, it is impossible to please God. That may seem like a strong statement—but it's a truth that brings both challenge and comfort.

To please God, we must do two things: believe that He exists and trust that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. This isn't about demanding blessings or guarantees of ease. It's about trusting that God's very nature is good, and that He honors the pursuit of His presence.

Faith means trusting even when we don't see results right away. It's choosing to believe in God's promises when our circumstances seem to say otherwise. It's continuing to pray, to hope, and to obey—because we know who He is.

Hebrews 11 goes on to list people who lived by such faith—Abraham, Moses, Noah, Sarah. They didn't live perfect lives, but they believed God and followed Him into the unknown. Their lives remind us that faith is not a feeling, but a decision to trust. So today, ask yourself: Am I living by faith, or just by sight? Am I seeking God because I truly believe He is real and good, or am I holding back until I see the proof I want? Faith pleases God because it places Him at the center—not just of our belief, but of our trust.

PRAYER

Lord, help me to live with faith that pleases You. Even when I can't see the full picture, let me trust in who You are. Give me the courage to seek You earnestly and to believe that You are with me, rewarding those who follow You in faith.
